

Nathan Hoppe has served as an OCMC (Orthodox Christian Mission Centre) missionary in Albania under the direction of Archbishop Anastasios for more than 25 years. Nathan, together with his wife Gabriela, directs the Central Children's Office of the Orthodox Church of Albania with a staff of 15 full-time workers. The ministry of the Children's Office is focused on fostering and facilitating the life of local Eucharistic communities through ministry to children and their families. Nathan is a Lecturer at Logos University in the Department of Theology and Culture and represents the Orthodox Church of Albania in a variety of venues including the official dialogues with the

Roman Catholic Church, the Lutheran World Federation, and the worldwide Anglican Communion. Nathan is the author of a new book entitled, *Fostering Local Eucharistic Communities*, based on his years of service in Albania and his academic research at St. Vladimir's Seminary.

Nathan was born and raised in Colombia, South America, where his mother continues to serve as a missionary. He holds master's degrees from Wheaton College and Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology and a D. Min. (Doctor of Ministry) from St. Vladimir's Theological Seminary.
